Starter's Guide to Your Dutch Language Course A1.2

Welcome to our Dutch language program! This guide provides all the information you need to get started and make the most of your learning experience with us.

General

Language Levels

Our courses are aligned with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Each level requires a different amount of practice hours, increasing as you progress. To reach **A1 level**, you need approximately **90 hours** of practice. In class, we cover 40 hours, while the remaining ±50 hours are dedicated to self-study. This includes homework and exposure to the language in other forms, such as: watching TV shows, talking with others, actively thinking in Dutch, texting in WhatsApp, engaging with our Instagram posts, etc.

With a weekly amount of 2 hours of class time and 2 hours of homework, you will have 4 hours of practice each week. At this pace, it would take around 20 weeks to reach Al level.

Since this is quite a commitment, we've divided our courses into manageable modules of 2-3 months. All classes are 1 hour long, with an average of 1 hour of homework between sessions. This schedule allows you to comfortably absorb the material and consistently progress towards your language goal. (A tailored schedule can be discussed.)

Course Structure

You are going to follow the **A1.2 course**, which consists of **18 hours of classes**. This guides you to a solid **A1 level**. After completing this course, you can seamlessly continue with the A2.1 course and be on your way to A2 proficiency.
